Berries & eating green shoots raw may cause dermatitis

### **Poisonous Parts**

Flowers, leaves, juice & seeds  
Seeds, leaves, and bark  
Inner seed

Hulls and bark  
Chestnut buds, nuts, leaves, bark, seedlings and honey
