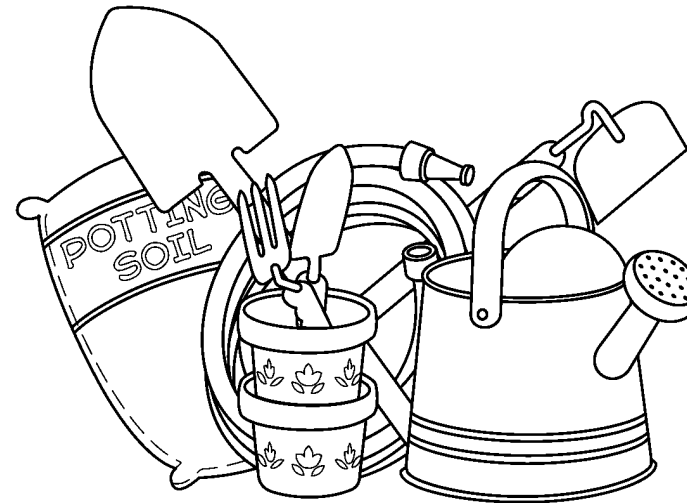

Master Gardener Training

Our classes are designed to train our volunteers to serve their community educating the public on horticulture. The Master Gardener program offers a minimum of 50 hours of instruction. Texas AgriLife Extension specialists, staff and local experts teach the classes. Taking the course includes a commitment to attend all the classes, successfully complete eight open-book, take-home tests; volunteer 50 hours with Bastrop County Master Gardeners over a 12-month period; and share what you learn with the community and others.
