Mission, Objectives and Values

MISSION: The Bell County Master Gardeners Association assists the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in providing high quality, relevant, research-based horticultural education and service to the residents of Bell County and the state of Texas through outreach, teaching, and demonstration projects.

STATEMENT: Program objectives are implemented through the training of local volunteers known as Master Gardeners.
