





# Advanced Master Gardener Training Rainwater Harvesting May 7, 14, & 21 Online Course Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, Tarrant County 1801 Circle Dr., Fort Worth, Texas 76119

#### **Advanced Training Purpose:**

To provide advanced training whereby Master Gardeners can obtain specialization in areas that support or expand designed programs of Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service.

#### Advanced Master Gardener Training - Rainwater Harvesting:

The Advanced Master Gardener Rainwater Harvesting training was created as a hands-on, intensive multi-day training that empowers Master Gardeners with knowledge and skills required to effectively support and multiply Texas A&M AgriLife Extension efforts in educational programs. The Spring 2021 sessions will be taught virtually, due to Covid 19. The class will teach you about rainwater harvesting from 55 gallon rain barrels up to large home or commercial systems, explain how to hold a rain barrel class in your county, work with water utility providers, groundwater conservation districts, stormwater departments, groups in your county and provide the support you need to teach others.

Master Gardeners who fulfill specified training and volunteer requirements will be recognized as an Advanced Master Gardener in the specific field of Rainwater Harvesting. This certification does not empower the individual with supervisory or administrative authority within his/her local county programs.

#### **Participation Requirements:**

To be eligible for the Advanced Master Gardener – Rainwater Harvesting training, an individual must possess an upto-date Master Gardener certification, or be an employee of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service. Master Gardener application must be approved by their local County Extension Agent.

#### Advanced Master Gardener Training - Rainwater Harvesting:

The Advanced Master Gardener Training – Rainwater Harvesting program is designed to train and certify Master Gardeners to become part of a state corps of Rainwater Harvesting experts and educators. To become a certified Advanced Master Gardener in Rainwater Harvesting, Master Gardeners are required to attend the Advanced Master Gardener in Rainwater Harvesting training to fulfill training requirements and subsequently meet service requirements described below. The Spring 2021 sessions will be taught virtually, due to Covid 19. Training activities during the course will empower Master Gardeners to complete these service requirements.

#### **Position Description:**

The Advanced Master Gardener Training – Rainwater Harvesting is charged to increase awareness and provide training in Rainwater Harvesting in both home landscapes and commercial areas.

#### Time Commitment:

The Master Gardener is required to serve a minimum of one year as an Advanced Master Gardener in Rainwater Harvesting providing a minimum of 20 hours of service. Service includes training Master Gardeners in their county, presenting the information to at least 3 other groups and setting up a demonstration in their county.

#### **Training and Service Requirements:**

- Attend the Online Advanced Master Gardener Rainwater Harvesting training
   The Spring 2021 RWH Advanced Training will be taught virtually, due to Covid 19.
- Serve as a local Advanced Master Gardener Rainwater Harvesting resource
- Assist with Rainwater Harvesting training for Master Gardeners and trainees
- Conduct community/youth Rainwater Harvesting education programs
- Increase clientele knowledge about Rainwater Harvesting through: presentation, workshops and mass media efforts (i.e., radio, newspaper, television, newsletters)

#### **Specialist Recognition and Certification:**

Upon completion of the Advanced Master Gardener – Rainwater Harvesting service requirements, the Master Gardener will be formally recognized at the annual Texas Master Gardener Conference, at which time they will be awarded an Advanced Master Gardener Certificate.
