85 days. A beautiful orange beefsteak preserved by our friend Darrell Kellogg, a railroad supervisor from Redford, Michigan. Its fruit is very flavorful and superbly sweet! This delicious heirloom originated in West Virginia. This giant sets fruit weighing anywhere from 16 to 32 ounces. Slightly flattened, the globes are massive, hanging over the edges of sandwich bread.

Lucky Cross



Red-yellow bicolor, 8-14 oz fruit, Open pollinator. Cross found by Craig LeHoullier in 1993 between a bicolor and Brandywine. Lucky Cross' fruit are beautiful, bi-colored, large (sixteen to twenty ounces) with some ribbing at the shoulders. They are juicy, fruity, and similar in flavor to 'Little Lucky'.

Brandywine

Brandywine tomato is a "beefsteak" type tomato variety. It produces large pink-red fruit, slightly ribbed, each of which weighs 5 to 7 ounces. This very tasty tomato is a favorite of many who love its thick, heavy flesh that's very juicy. It's definitely among the most tasty tomatoes ever.

Paul Robeson

90 days. 7 to 10-oz fruit is a red-brick color. Paul Robeson is a beefsteak-type tomato, and its size and shape lend itself well for slicing atop salads and sandwiches, or it can be used in making a smoky-sweet tomato sauce. Its earthy flavor may also work nicely for use in juices and cocktail drinks.

Red Rose



This cross between Brandywine and Rutgers produces good yields of 6 to 10 oz. delicious dark pink fruit. Disease and crack-resistance are inherited from Rutgers, and the tomato's taste and texture is more like that of Brandywine.

Mortgage Lifter

Mortgage Lifter tomatoes are an open pollinated variety which produces a pinkish red, beefsteak-shaped fruit. Large, smooth, 1-lb pink fruit has a delicious, rich, sweet taste. These meaty tomatoes have few seeds and mature in approximately 80 to 85 days.

Giant Belgium



85 days, indeterminate — 'Giant Belgium', sometimes sold as 'Giant Belgium Pink', have fruits that have smooth blossoms ends, average one to two pounds each and are dark pink in color. They have a sweet, mild, low acid flavor. An excellent slicing variety and makes good juice.

Cherokee Purple

80 days. Cherokee Purple tomato has a dark, dusty rose color with green-tinged shoulders. They're very sweet and have a rich, almost smoky flavor. The fruit is large and refreshingly acidic, thick-skinned with an earthy, lingering flavor.

Sweetie Cherry

50-65 days. 1 inch in diameter, weight about an 1 oz. and high in sugar content. Sweetie Cherry Tomato is an open-pollinated, indeterminate cherry variety that produce heavy clusters of super sweet cherry tomatoes.
