TOMATOES - CHERRY CATEGORY



4th of July Tomato

Grows in clusters. Extra early and heavy producers. It is a non-cherry, good fresh or for canning. Globe shaped. 49 days to maturity. Fruit size 4 oz. Grows to 55" tall and 55" wide. Type: Indeterminate.



Barry Crazy Yellow Cherry Tomato

Sweet, pale, yellow fruit; oval with a tiny "beak" at the end. Initial tartness, followed by fruity sweetness. 40 to 60 fruit clusters on a large plant. 75 days to maturity. Fruit size 1". Grows to 5' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Chocolate Cherry Tomato

Heirloom that is loaded with dense clusters of sweet fruit. Brick red with chocolate shading weighing ½ to ¾ oz. Perfect for salads, slicing or canning. 70 days to maturity. Fruit size 1" to 1½" in diameter. Grows to 5-6' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Golden Cherry Tomato

Sweet tasting golden cherry tomato. 60 to 65 days to maturity. Fruit size 1". Grows to 3-4' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Large Red Cherry Tomato

Grows in clusters, up to five on the vine. Good for salads. Deep scarlet flavorful fruit. Green fruits may be pickled. 72 days to maturity. Fruit size 1-1¼" in diameter. Type: Indeterminate.



Red Cherry Flavor Bomb Tomato

Extremely sweet red cherry tomatoes. Very productive. Great for salads or snacking. 70 days to maturity. Fruit size 1". Grows to 3-4' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Supersweet 100 Cherry Tomato

Produces long strands of 15 or more sugary sweet cherry tomatoes. Extra high in Vitamin C. Great for snacking or salads. 65 days to maturity. Fruit size 1 oz and 1" in diameter. Requires staking. Type: Indeterminate.



Sweet Snak Cherry Tomato

Produces thousands of small, delicious nuggets of sweetness. Heavy producers and great for roasting, salads or just plain snacking. 60 days to maturity. Fruit size 1" in diameter. Type: Indeterminate.



Tropical Sunset Cherry Tomato

Gold with orange-pink stripping; nearly translucent when ripe. Flavor is fruity. 60-70 days to maturity. Size 1½" (ping-pong ball size). Type: Indeterminate.

Yellow Pear Cherry Tomato

An **Heirloom** tomato that produces small, 4 oz. yellow pear-shaped fruit. Sweet, mild flavor. Great for salads, snacking, or tomato preserves. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 1". Grows to 5 to 6+ feet tall. Type: Indeterminate.

TOMATOES - PASTE CATEGORY



Amish Paste Tomato

One of the most popular tomatoes for sauces and canning. Plant with basil to deter hornworms. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 8 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Andiamo Tomato

A San Marzano type tomato, produces heavy yields of bright red 5" elongated firm, meaty fruits. 65 days to maturity. Fruit size 5" elongated. Type: Indeterminate.



Juliet Tomato

Deep red. One of the most disease resistant to blight. Good for salads, salsa, and pasta sauce. Crack resistant. Clusters of 12-18 tomatoes. 60 days to maturity. Fruit size 2" long, 1½ -2 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Paisano Tomato

Thick-walled in San Marzano shape. Good flavor, high solids for sauce/canning. Concentrated sets at midseason. 68 days to maturity. Fruit size 4-5 oz. Type: Determinate.



San Marzano Tomato

An **Heirloom** plum tomato. Longer and thinner with sweet flavor, low acidity, firm pulp, less seeds. Best for canned tomatoes, great for sauces. 85 days to maturity. Likes full sun. Fruit size 4 oz. Grows to 6-8' tall. Type: Indeterminate.

TOMATOES - HEIRLOOM



Abraham Lincoln Tomato

Dark red. Fruity, sweet, solid and meaty. It is smooth and free from cracks and seams. Grows in clusters of nine tomatoes. 87 days to maturity. Fruit size 12 oz. Type: Indeterminate, Open-Pollinated.



Cherokee Purple Tomato

Giant beefsteak with intense violet-purple hues. Disease-tolerant variety that has a smoky, sweet flavor. Needs staking as it grows. 80 to 90 days to maturity. Fruit size 1 lb. Grows to 4-6' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Creole Tomato

Tolerates heat and humidity. Forms meaty tomatoes with outstanding flavor. Good for slicing and sandwiches. 72 days to maturity. Fruit size 8-12 oz. Grows to 4+ feet tall. Type: Indeterminate.

Jubilee Tomato

Golden orange. Weigh 6-7 oz. with meaty thick walls and few seeds. Mild but good tomato flavor. Excellent for slicing, salads, sandwiches and canning. 72-85 days to maturity. Fruit size 2-3" in diameter. Grows to 3-6' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Marglobe Tomato

Globe shaped. Extremely disease resistant and a good variety for a humid climate. Good for canning. 72 days to maturity. Fruit size 8 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Mortgage Lifter Tomato

Large pink tomatoes with a delicious, rich, sweet taste. Heavy producer. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 1-1½ lbs. Grows to 7-9' tall. Type: Indeterminate.

TOMATOES - SMALL CATEGORY (6-8 oz)



Black Beauty Tomato

A dark, meaty, red-fleshed tomato. Rich, smooth and savory flavor with earthy tones. Fruit is mature when green color has changed to dark red. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 3" in diameter. Grows to 3' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Bush Early Girl Tomato

Early ripening; large yields with good disease resistance. It is a compact 18" plant. 54 days to maturity. Fruit size 6-8 oz. Type: Determinate.



Campbell's 33 Tomato

Produces medium-early bright red fruits with green shoulders. Sets fruit well under unfavorable conditions. Tolerance to cracking. 69 days to maturity. Fruit size 7 oz. Type: Determinate.



Defiant Tomato

Resistant to the modern strain of late blight, but also resistant to early blight. High yielding globe-shaped fruits with great old-fashioned tomato flavor. 70 days to maturity. Fruit size 6-8 oz. Type: Determinate.



Early Girl Tomato

A medium sized red globe hybrid tomato popular because it ripens fruit early. 50 days to maturity. Fruit size 6-8 oz. Grows to 6-9' tall and 3-4' wide. Type: Indeterminate.



Goliath Sunny Tomato

A yellow-gold variation of the red Goliath variety. Juicy, mild and sweet. May be harvested when it first turns yellow or left to reach a shade of gold. Low in acidity. Will continually set fruit from the bottom up. 70 days to maturity. Fruit size 7-8 oz. Type: Indeterminate.

Jet Star Tomato

Produces big yields of large fruit that are free of cracks and scars. Great slicing tomato. Also great for salads, canning and sauces. 72 days to maturity. Fruit size 7-9 oz. Grows to 3-5' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Jetsetter Tomato

Matures earlier with better disease resistance. Delivers great "real tomato" flavor. Smooth and juicy with a flattened globe shape. Consistently huge yield. 64 days to maturity. Fruit size 8 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Rutgers Tomato

Red fruit with great flavor for both slicing and cooking. 74 days to maturity. Fruit size 4-7 oz. Grows to 68-80" tall. Type: Determinate.

TOMATOES - MEDIUM (8-12 oz)



Amelia Tomato

Specially bred for Southeastern gardens. Thrives in hot climates. Excellent when picked green or red. Good for sandwiches, salads and salas. Good crack resistance. Performs best with moderate pruning. 75 days to maturity. Fruit size 8-10 oz. Type: Determinate.



Bella Rosa Tomato

Large, round and deep red. Firm fruits with great tomato flavor. Excellent disease resistance. Grows well in hot and humid climates. Remarkable productivity – expect big yields. 70 days to maturity. Fruit size 10-12 oz. Grows to 4' tall. Type: Determinate.



Bodacious Tomato

Large, round and disease resistant. Good for sandwiches, burgers, and salads. Grows in large clusters, 40-50 tomatoes per plant. Easy to pick, no cracking. 80-85 days to maturity. Fruit size 10-12 oz. Grows to 5-6' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Bush Big Boy Tomato

Large, red, sweet, juicy tomatoes. A compact plant; good for use in containers or small spaces. 68 days to maturity. Fruit size: 10-11 oz. Grows to 3-5' tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Darkstar Tomato

A modern hybrid tomato. Early maturing, a rich purple with fewer blemishes and a high yield. 70-75 days to maturity. Fruit size 8-10 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Goliath Bush Tomato

Developed especially for patio gardeners and those with limited garden space. The fruits have flavorful meat and are high in sugar content. Bears fruit consistently up to frost and needs little staking. 68 days to maturity. Fruit size 3-4". Grows up to 3½' tall. Type: Determinate.

Goliath Early Tomato

Continuous production, luscious flavor, and broad disease resistance. Expect extra-large harvests of sweet fruits. Extends the growing season at the front end by almost a week. 60 days to maturity. Fruit size 7-10½ oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Goliath Original Hybrid (Variety "Pio")

“Pio” is a sweet, deep oblate fruit. It has a blemish-free exterior. Tall, vigorous producer of yield after yield. Resistant to Nematodes. 65 days to maturity. Fruit size: 10-15 oz. Type: Indeterminate.



Jolene Tomato

Smooth, deep red beefsteak that sets fruit in heat when other tomatoes will not. Resistant to Tomato Yellow Leaf Curl Virus for growers in the Deep South. 79 days to maturity. Fruit size 8-10 oz. Type: Determinate.



Red Snapper Tomato

The “2020 San Antonio Rodeo Tomato”. Bush growth, big yield of round, large to extra large fruit. Great for mature green tomatoes too. 75 days to maturity. Fruit size: 8-12 oz. Type: Determinate.



Roadster Tomato

A hybrid with candy apple red fruit with superior flavor. Early maturing, 65 days to maturity. Fruit size 8-12 oz. Type: Determinate.



Wisconsin 55 Tomato

Scarlet-red, round, mid-sized slicing tomato. Juicy, but never mushy. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 8 oz. Type: Indeterminate.

TOMATOES - LARGE/EXTRA LARGE (16-24 oz)



Beefsteak Tomato

Excellent productivity. Meaty flesh and classic beefsteak flavor. Ideal for eating fresh or slicing for sandwiches. 80 days to maturity. Size: 1-2 lbs. Grows to 36-42” tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Better Boy Tomato

Deep red, smooth, and firm fruits. Delicious meaty flavor. Produces many large, flavorful fruits with excellent disease resistance. 70 to 75 days to maturity. Fruit size 1-1½ lbs. Grows to 5-8’ tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Henderson Pink Ponderosa Tomato

Heirloom tomato. Pinkish, meaty, juicy tomato with a creamy texture. It yields a heavy beefsteak size fruit in clusters of 3-5 fruits. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size up to 16 oz. Vines can grow to 6-8’. Type: Indeterminate.

Orange Slice Tomato

Produces a large crop of bright orange, firm, juicy beefsteak tomatoes. Robust flavor. 75 days to maturity. Fruit size 1 lb. Grows to 52-54" tall. Type: Indeterminate.



Perfectly Pink Tomato

Worth the wait for the tasty summer treat. The attractive beefsteak-type fruits are juicy, super sweet, and the perfect one slicer. 95 days to maturity. Fruit size 1 lb. Type: Indeterminate.

PEPPERS - BELL CATEGORY



Autry Bell Pepper

Performs very well in the southeast; a high yield vigorous plant. Large blocky fruit. Maturity: 60 days to green, 80 days to red ripe.



California Wonder Bell Pepper

Oldest and largest **Heirloom** bell pepper. Mild flavor, sweet, thick walled, medium sized plant. Heavy bearing and vigorous. Fruit is 4" long. 75 days to maturity.



Flavor Burst Bell Pepper

A vibrant golden yellow pepper after the initial color of lime green. Excellent sweet flavor. Fruit are medium-large, 3 lobed and slightly elongated. Maturity: 67 days to green, 87 days to yellow ripe.



Green Machine Bell Pepper

Ideal for Spring and Summer-sown crops in the Southeast. The vigorous plants provide good leaf cover to protect the fruit. Fruit are medium-large to large and extra blocky. Maturity: 60 days green, 80 days red ripe.



Olly Bell Pepper

An early red bell pepper. Excellent for heated or unheated greenhouses or tunnels. High yields. Fruit size: medium-large. Maturity: 54 days green, 74 days red ripe.



Olympus Bell Pepper

Widely adapted with good performance in the South. Good flavor. Fruit size: large. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days red ripe.



Red Knight Bell Pepper

A big, blocky fruit early to turn red. Strong disease resistance and a more compact open plant. Fruit size: large. Maturity: 57 days green, 77 days red ripe.

SVPB 8415 Bell Pepper

Has full resistance to bacterial leaf spot (BLS). Fruit size: medium to medium-large, smooth, blocky, slightly elongated. Maturity: 73 days green, 93 days yellow ripe.



SVPB 8500 Bell Pepper

An orange bell pepper. Resistant to bacterial leaf spot (BLS). Does well in the South. Fruit size: large blocky. Maturity: 71 days green, 91 days orange ripe.



Sweet Sunrise Bell Pepper

Has a fruity sweet flavor. Yields well and fruits ripen early. Fruit are medium-large 3 & 4 lobed, blocky to slightly elongated. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days yellow ripe.



Yolo Wonder Bell Pepper

Classic bell peppers which are also an **Heirloom**. Perfect for stuffing, grilling or dicing. Fruit size: 4" bell. 75-80 days to maturity.

PEPPERS - SWEET CATEGORY



Carnival Blend Pepper

A colorful mix of classic gold, orange, red, purple and ivory bell peppers. These varieties include California Wonder, Orange Sun and Purple Beauty. Harvest as soon as they reach full size. Fruit size 3-4". 70 days to maturity.



Cornito Arancia Pepper

Exceptionally sweet; perfect for grilling & roasting. Productive plants. Type: Corno di Toro. Fruit size 1-½" by 5" long. Maturity: 60 days green, 80 days orange ripe.



Cornito Rosso Pepper

Very Early. Perfect for grilling and roasting. Type: Corno di Toro. Fruit size 1-1½" x 5" long. Maturity: 60 days green, 80 days ripe red.



Corno Rosso Pepper

Corno di Toro Rosso "red horn of the bull". Classic Italian **Heirloom** sweet pepper. Produces tasty, tapering peppers perfect for roasting, stuffing, frying or preserving. Grows to 3-4'. Type: Corno di Toro. Fruit size 6-8" long. Maturity: 72 days.



Crispy Sweet Pepper

Ripens to red early and is great for stuffing and salads. Has very thick walls. Grows to 3' tall. Fruit is 3-4 lobed. Maturity: 70 days red ripe.

Grand Bell Mix Pepper

High yielding plant that produces plenty of peppers for salads & vegetable dishes. The plants offer a rainbow of colors that are crisp & sweet. Color & sweetness increase the longer they are left on the plant. Freezes well. 65-80 days to maturity.



Long Pepper Blend

Sweet long pepper mix of a sweet & mild variety. An equal mix of Corno di Toro Pepper & Sweet Banana Pepper. Container friendly. 72 days to maturity.



Soroksari Pepper

A Balkan **Heirloom**. Almost translucent, pale yellow in color. Very sweet for fresh use & stuffing. Fully ripened and dried, it acquires a deeper orange/red color & makes a good paprika. Grows to 2-3' tall. Fruit size: 3-4 lobes to possibly a point. 66 days to maturity.

PEPPERS - HOT CATEGORY



Ancho Gigantia Pepper

Perfect fresh, roasted or stuffed. They can be dried at the red stage. Can be eaten at either red or green stage. 80 days to maturity. Fruit size 3" x 2 1/4". Type: Ancho, mildly hot.



Baron Pepper

A large, highly adaptable poblano pepper. The fruits are typically 2-lobed, which makes them easy to stuff and cook in their signature dish, Chile Rellenos. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days red ripe. Fruit size 5" x 3". Type: Poblano.



Capperino Pepper

Perfect pepper for stuffing. Moderate heat level. Maturity: 60 days green, 85 days red ripe. Fruit size 1 1/2" in diameter. Plant height: medium. Type: Cherry.



Charger Pepper

Large and thick walled, making them suitable for frying and stuffing. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days red ripe. Fruit size averages 7" by 2". Plant height: very large. Type: Anaheim.



Cowhorn Pepper

Tapered, thick-walled, cayenne peppers that have a curled horn shape and mature from green to bright red. 75 days to maturity. Fruit size 6-9". Type: Cayenne.



Flaming Flare Pepper

Conical-shaped and thin walled. Ripen to bright red. Flavor is sweet, mildly hot. Excellent for fresh use, stir fries, and sauteing. Maturity: 67 days green, 77 days red ripe. Fruit size 4" long.

Jalapeño Pepper, Early

Smaller traditional size. Come in earlier and yield a lower amount of jalapeños. Maturity: 60 days green, 80 days red ripe. Fruit size 2-2 ½". Plant height: small. Type: Jalapeño.



Jalapeño Pepper, Black Pepper Joe

A variety bred to be almost totally black. It goes from green to black and finally to red at maturity. 80-89 days to maturity. Fruit size 3-4". Grows to 2-3'. Type: mild.



New Mexico (Hatch) Chile Pepper

Peppers are sweet and smoky. They are a good source of vitamins A, C, and E, potassium and calcium. The plant is mostly compact with an intermediate number of stems with 10-20 pods. Maturity: 80 days, dark green to red. Fruit size 7" long. Type: medium hot.



Sergento Pepper

A Poblano pepper with 2 or 3 lobes. The fruits are very dark green, shiny and smooth. Plants are vigorous and have excellent yield. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days red ripe. Fruit Size 5-6" long by 3" wide. Type: Poblano.



Spitfire Pepper

Plant is large, sturdy, upright and bushy. Bears heavy yield of uniform peppers. Maturity: 65 days green, 85 days red ripe. Fruit Size 7-9" long by 2½-3" wide. Type: Anaheim, slightly hot.



SVHJ 5816 Pepper

A new jalapeño that matures early and has a good fruit color, large size, and high yield potential. Improved disease resistance. Maturity: 70 days green, 90 red days ripe. Fruit Size 3½-4". Plant height: medium-large plant. Type: Jalapeño.

HERBS



Arugula

Fast-growing leafy vegetable grown as a flavorful salad green. Tart and peppery flavor; great for pesto or a pizza garnish. Cold-season vegetable. Plant in the early spring or late summer. Annual. Grows to 2-3' tall. Full sun, partial shade. Loam, moist, well-drained soil.



Basil, Asian Sweet Thai

Spicy flavor reminiscent of anise and cloves. Goes well in curries and many other Asian dishes. Annual. Moist, rich, well-drained soil. Grows to 16-20" tall.



Basil, Dark Opal

Upright, bushy herb with edible deep purple leaves. Intense sweet-spicy flavor and pretty pinkish flowers. Use in flavored vinegar, garnish or in salads. Annual. Full sun. Grows to 12-18" tall. Keep well-watered.

Basil, Genovese

Extremely tender, fragrant with extra-large, dark green leaves. Superb for pesto. Annual. Full sun. Keep well-watered. Grows to 18-24" tall.



Basil, Holy (Tulsi)

Member of the mint family. Can be infused into herbal tea and put in smoothies. Bubble-gum scent, frost-tolerant and fast-growing. Flowers are a bee magnet. Sun/partial shade. Well-drained rich humus soil. Consistent moisture.



Basil, Italian Cameo

Fragrant leaves are combined with a compact habit. Classic basil flavor. Enjoy in containers, window boxes, beds and borders. Full sun. Grows to 1' tall. Rich, well-drained soil. Fertilize every 2 weeks.



Basil, Lemon

Distinct lemon scent and flavor; mild enough for grilled fish or shrimp. Use fresh and add during the last moments of cooking. Add to pasta, vegetables, soups, and sauces. Full sun. Average water needs. Well-drained soil.



Basil, Lime

Sweet and fragrant with a mild citrus taste. Use in stir fry, fish, and poultry dishes. Matches well with tomato-flavored dishes, pasta sauces, and vegetables. Full Sun to partial shade. Keep well-watered and mulched. Pinch back to encourage branching and leaf production.



Basil, Sweet

Aromatic leaves excellent with tomatoes, lamb and mild vegetables. Good for growing in containers. To harvest the leaves, pinch the stems just above a set of leaves. Annual. Full sun. Grows to 12-18" tall. Keep well-watered.



Catnip

Heart-shaped leaves that cats love. Catnip is an aggressive grower and can take over your garden so best to grow in pots. Full sun. Light, well-composted and well-draining soil. Grows to 2-3' tall.



Chives, Garlic

Graceful herb with broad, flat green leaves. Strong garlic flavor and a wide variety of culinary uses. Add chives to herbal vinegars, salads, soups, soft cheeses, butters, or grilled meat. Grows to 1-3' high. Drought tolerant. Can be grown as a border. Full sun to partial shade. Perennial, long-lived.



Choi Sum

Similar to bok choy but has longer stalks and is more tender. It can be sauteed or used in stir fries and soups. Cool weather. Sun to part shade. Fertile, moist, well-drained soil. Grows and matures in about 30 days.

Dill, Bouquet

Highly aromatic with large, yellow flower heads. Use leaves to flavor dishes or seed clusters to make dill pickles. Annual. Morning sun and afternoon shade. Grows to 26-36" tall. Average water needs.



Dill, Fernleaf

Shorter variety dill with slender stems and delicate leaves. Ideal for containers. Dill will attract the black swallowtail butterflies and their larva. Harvest dill any time. Grows to 18-24" tall. Morning sun. Rich, well-drained soil. Consistent moisture.



Dill, Mammoth

Frilly and flavorful. Snip leaves for salads, dips and seafood. Harvest seed to flavor breads and pickles. Doesn't like heat. Annual, cold hardy. Morning sun and afternoon shade. Average water needs. Grows to 2-4' tall.



Eggplant, Chinese String

Slender, tender and sweet tasting. High-yielding plants of 10-15" long fruit. Delicious raw in salads or sautéed or grilled. Full sun. Hot weather. Loamy, well-drained soil. Keep well-watered and consistently moist.



Fenugreek (Methi)

Cultivated worldwide. Seeds and leaves are used in cooking in Indian and Asian cuisine. Maple syrup like flavor. Used in curry, dal, pickles, and spice mixes. Can use fresh or dried. Average, well-draining soil. Full sun to partial shade. Water to keep it moist. Grows to 2' tall.



Komatsuna

A very popular Asian green. Flavor is a mild mustard and cabbage combination. Steam or use in stir fries and soups. Young leaves can be mixed in salads. Annual. Full sun. Rich, well-drained soil. Keep moist. Fertilize occasionally.



Lovage

Bright, fresh flavor that tastes a bit like citrusy celery. Can be used in dips, soups, salads. Does best in cool weather. Full sun, part shade. Grows to 6' tall. Sandy, loamy soil. Keep soil moist at all times.



Parsley, Extra Triple-Curled

Extra curly leaves. Delicious in salads or on vegetables and potatoes. Leaves freeze well. Used in vinegar or herbed butters. Biennial herb. Keep well-watered. Full sun or partial shade. Grows to 12-16" tall.



Parsley, Italian Flat-leaf

Flat leaves popular in Mediterranean and Middle Eastern cuisine. Use in salads, soups, butters, fish, and poultry dishes. Frost tolerant. Part shade especially in the summer. Grows to 24" tall. Moist, rich soil.

Parsley, Moss Curled

Dark green, curly leaves. Use in salads, casseroles and omelets or as a decorative garnish. Biennial herb. An easy, fast grower. Full sun or partial shade. Grows to 12-16" tall.



Sage, Broad Leaf

Fragrant grey-green herb with oblong leaves and purple flowers. Use in soups, stuffing, and meat dishes. Full sun and hot weather. Well-drained, moderately dry soil. Grows to 12-24" tall. Harvest leaves when young.



Salad Burnet

Clean, cucumber-like flavor. Use in salads, dips, soups, and vinegars. Easy-growing plant that appears early in the season and holds up well in the heat. Perennial. Grows to 10-24" tall and 1-2' wide. Full sun to partial shade. Semi-moist, well-drained soil.



Thyme, Common

Flavorful Mediterranean herb used in many world cuisines. Pairs well with garlic, olive oil, and tomatoes. Perennial. Full Sun. Grows to 6-12" tall. Sandy, loamy soil. Does not require much fertilizer or water.

OTHER



Bluebonnets

Plant in full sun, 8-10 hours, in well-draining soil. Try planting in raised beds, whiskey barrels or clay pots. Don't bury the crown of transplants or the plant may rot. Water transplants only when top one inch of soil is dry. No application of fertilizer is required but it may help produce abundant bloom. To keep them blooming longer, remove old blossoms. Pill bugs eat bluebonnets but a bait can help control them. Don't overwater....they are very drought tolerant.
