Texas AgriLife Extension Brazoria County Master Gardener Opportunity Grant Guidelines

- 1. Grants are available to certified Brazoria County Master Gardeners who have completed the 60-hour training requirement and are actively participating in the program.
- 2. Grants will be awarded based on the educational needs of Brazoria County residents and on the resources available to fill those needs as determined by the Opportunity Grant Committee.
- 3. Grant amounts will be based on the cost of the training course.
- 4. Application must be made at least 14 days prior to the start date of the training course.
- 5. Reimbursement will be made upon completion of the course.
- 6. Course certification hours can be counted as volunteer hours to the Brazoria County Master Gardener Association.
- 7. Grantees agree to use the knowledge gained in their training to educate Master Gardeners and the gardening public. Requirements for volunteerism are generally set by the certifying entity. If not, the opportunity grant committee will set the requirement.
- 8. The volunteerism requirement must be fulfilled within 24 months following completion of the training class.
