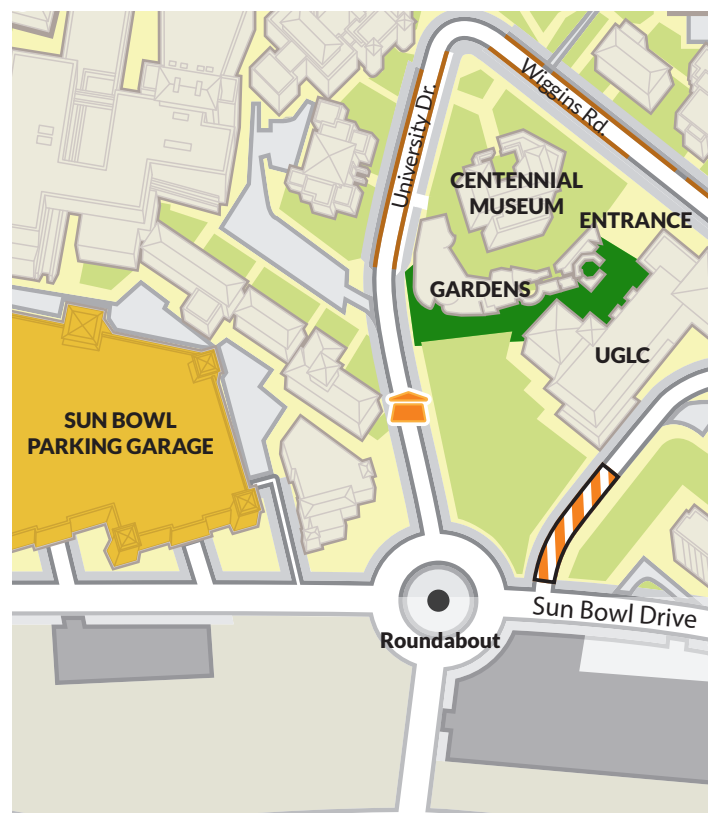
FLORAFEST 2017
