Henderson County Master Gardener Association (HCMGA) will host Shirley Niswonger of Shirley Nice Flowers on Tuesday, February 20, 5:30 p.m. at the Clint W. Murchison Memorial Library, 121 S. Prairieville, Athens. Niswonger will present "Growing a Cutting Garden". This free presentation is open to the public.



Are you interested in growing your own flowers for bouquets and arrangements? Do you want to be able to bring the beauty or scent of some of your blooms indoors? Perhaps you wish to share your garden's splendor with others. During this presentation, Niswonger will teach you how to put in a cutting garden of your own.

Niswonger began her floral design career with training from the New York Botanical Gardens in the Bronx, obtaining her floral design certificate in 2001. Before moving to Texas in 2012, she designed flowers for weddings and other events in California.

Now living in Athens, Niswonger has continued making floral arrangements for clients as well as friends, family, and for her personal enjoyment.
