

## FLAX LILY 'CASSA BLUE'<sup>™</sup>

*Dianella caerulea* 'Cassa Blue'<sup>™</sup>

### Characteristics

- Type: Perennial
- Zone: 7-11
- Habit: Dwarf
- Sun: Partial shade to full sun
- Height: 1.5 to 2 feet
- Spread: 1.5 to 2 feet
- Foliage color: Blue-green
- Blooms: Spring
- Flower color: Blue
- Blooms: Showy
- Water: Drought tolerant, once established

### Culture

An extremely versatile and easy care dwarf selection with lush blue-green foliage and small violet flower clusters followed by attractive purple berries. Slow growing and clump-forming; doesn't spread widely by rhizomes. An excellent mass planting or border in front of shrubs. Hardy and adaptable, tolerates salt spray and drought. Evergreen.

### Noteworthy Characteristics

'Cassa Blue' Dianella has a lovely erect, blueish foliage which provides an interesting texture in your garden. It will grow to approximately 2 feet in height & width and in spring it produces lovely blue flowers on spikes for added interest. It is an Australian Native, and therefore extremely hardy, suited to many conditions and requiring no maintenance. It can be also be used as a border plant. Using this plant with other contrasting plants will enhance any garden. Plant in full sun to light shade and irrigate only occasionally unless drought conditions occur. Grows well in sandy soils and reportedly tolerates heavy clay if planted on a slope or mound to insure adequate drainage.

### Problems

No serious disease or pest problems.

Borders, rock gardens, accent plant, xeriscape, mass plantings.
