Comments: Texas native, more upright than live oaks

Common Name: Dragon Tree

Botanical Name: Dracaena marginata

Type: House plant Height: 6 feet

Light: Bright, indirect light

Moisture: Water well and don't water again until the top 50% of the soil is dry.

Soil: Loose, quick-draining

Bloom: Fragrant tiny white flowers in spring; rarely appear indoors

Comments: Features the narrowest leaves of the various species of dracaena

## **VEGETABLES**

Common name: Longevity Spinach Botanical name: Gynura procumbens Type: Tender perennial vegetable

Height: To 2 feet with stems up to 20 feet Light: Moderately sunny but not full sun

Moisture: Likes a lot of water but do not keep soggy

Bloom: Orange blooms not often seen

Comments: Use as you would spinach and in salads. May freeze here so overwinter a few cuttings

inside. Sometimes used as a houseplant

Note: Not easy to find

Common name: Chaya, Spinach Tree, Mayan Miracle Plant

Botanical name: Cnidoscolus aconitifolius

Type: Tender perennial vegetable

Height: Up to 15 feet Light: Sun to semi-shade

Moisture: Drought tolerant but grows faster with regular water, does not like being soggy

Bloom: Very rarely blooms

Comments: This can be kept as a bush or small tree. Hand sized leaves are "meaty" and delicious, should always be cooked before eating. May or may not come back after freezing but grows quickly

so keep a cutting or two indoors over winter. This is a non-stinging variety.

Note: 4" pots are selling for as much as \$25 on Etsy and EBay, fairly rare vegetable.

Type: Vining houseplant Height: Stems vine 60'-65'

Light: Performs well in both bright or indirect sunlight and strong artificial light.

Moisture: Water once or twice each week, will not tolerate standing water, does best in average to

evenly moist soil

Bloom: Flowers are not ornamentally significant.

Comments: Air purifier
