Garden of Tommi and John Larrison: Large gardens with multiple water catchment systems.



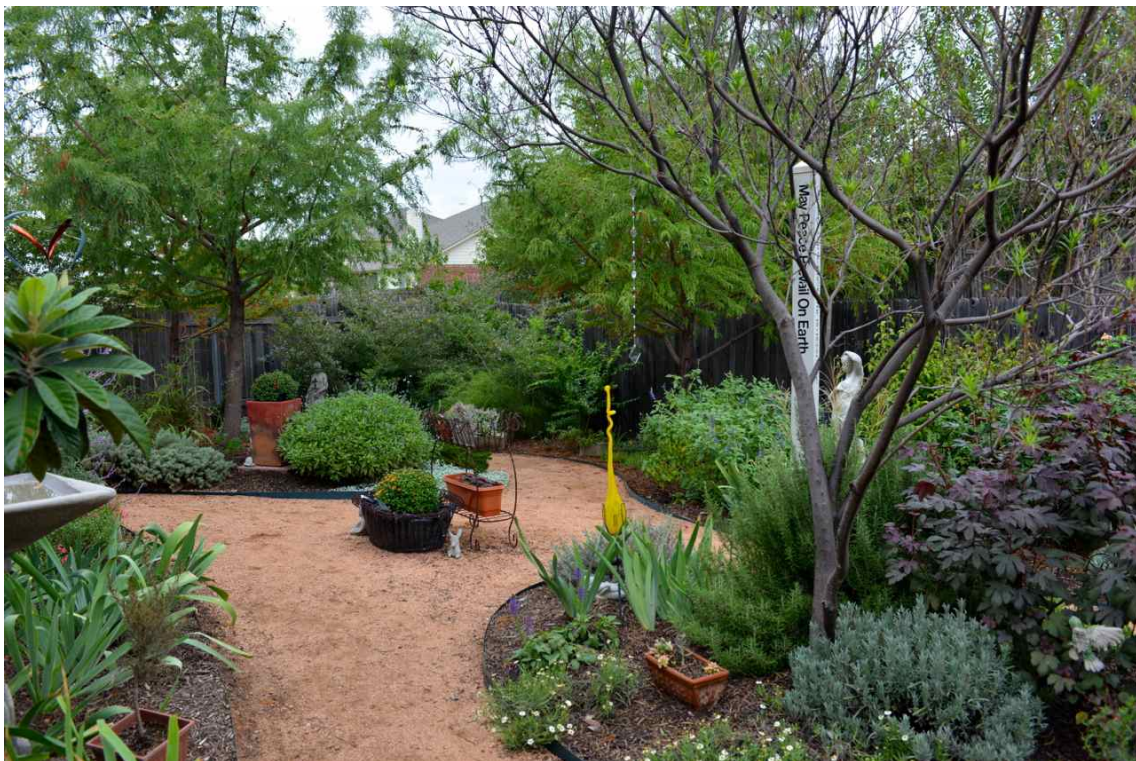
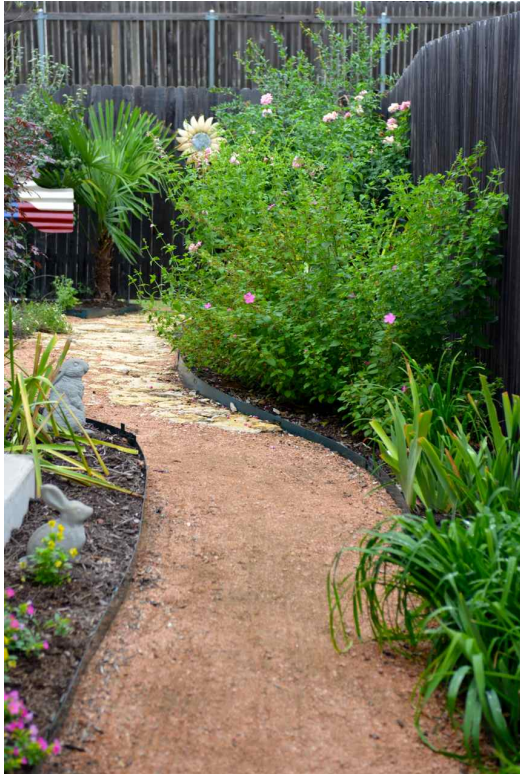
Garden of Jodie Beach: Certified Wildlife Habitat with water catchment and yard art on two acres
